By the end of February, KG2 students will have achieved the following:

English Language Arts

1. Oral Language & Vocabulary:

- Use position and action words.
- Categorize and classify vocabulary words related to different jobs.
- Use describing words, such as cold, snow, bear, snores, doctor, firefighter, carpenter, roadwork, sounds...
- Retell the story structure (beginning, middle and end).
- Name the character and setting.
