


KG3 Monthly Module December 2018

By the end of December, KG3 students will have achieved the following:

I. Language Arts: English

a) Oral Language & Vocabulary:

- Identify the purpose of a story and note details
- Make predictions and draw conclusions
- Identify genre of a story (Fantasy vs. Realistic texts)
- Recognize sequence of events
- Read and write high frequency words: what, look, who, from, good, on, but, out, down, he, she, will, do.

b) Phonological Awareness:

- Identify and blend short vowels e and i in CVC words
- Read and write CVC words
- Review the letters Cc, Uu, Ww, Ii, Ee
- Blend beginning and ending sounds with the short vowels e and i
- Identify capitalization and end punctuation: full stop (.), question mark (?)

c) Songs:

- Jingle Bells
- Santa Claus is Coming to Town
- Oh, What a Special Night
- Joy to the World
- Christ is born

II. Mathematics:

- Classify objects into categories
- Count the number of objects in each category
- Compare and order numbers 0-10
- Sort the categories by counting
- Describe, identify and compare 2D and 3D shapes
- Identify different positions of shapes

- Critique reasoning
- Compare numbers to 10

III. Science:

- Name the main body parts
- Describe ways of taking care of your body
- Identify the function of each sense
- Identify the function of each body part

IV. Sports:

- Practice various body movements
- Speed game (race)

V. Psychomotor skills:

- Consolidate the recognition of all parts of the body on oneself and others
- Strengthen parts of the body schema on others
