I. Language Arts: English

a) Oral Language & Vocabulary:

- Recognize parts of a book: front cover, back cover, title, author, illustrator and photographer.
- Use left to right directionality in reading and writing.
- Recognize and differentiate between a fantasy story and a real one.
- Identify story structure: beginning, middle and end.
- Recall main details in a story.
- Make predictions and draw conclusions.
