But look! A big, big bone is in the hole! It is such a big bone.

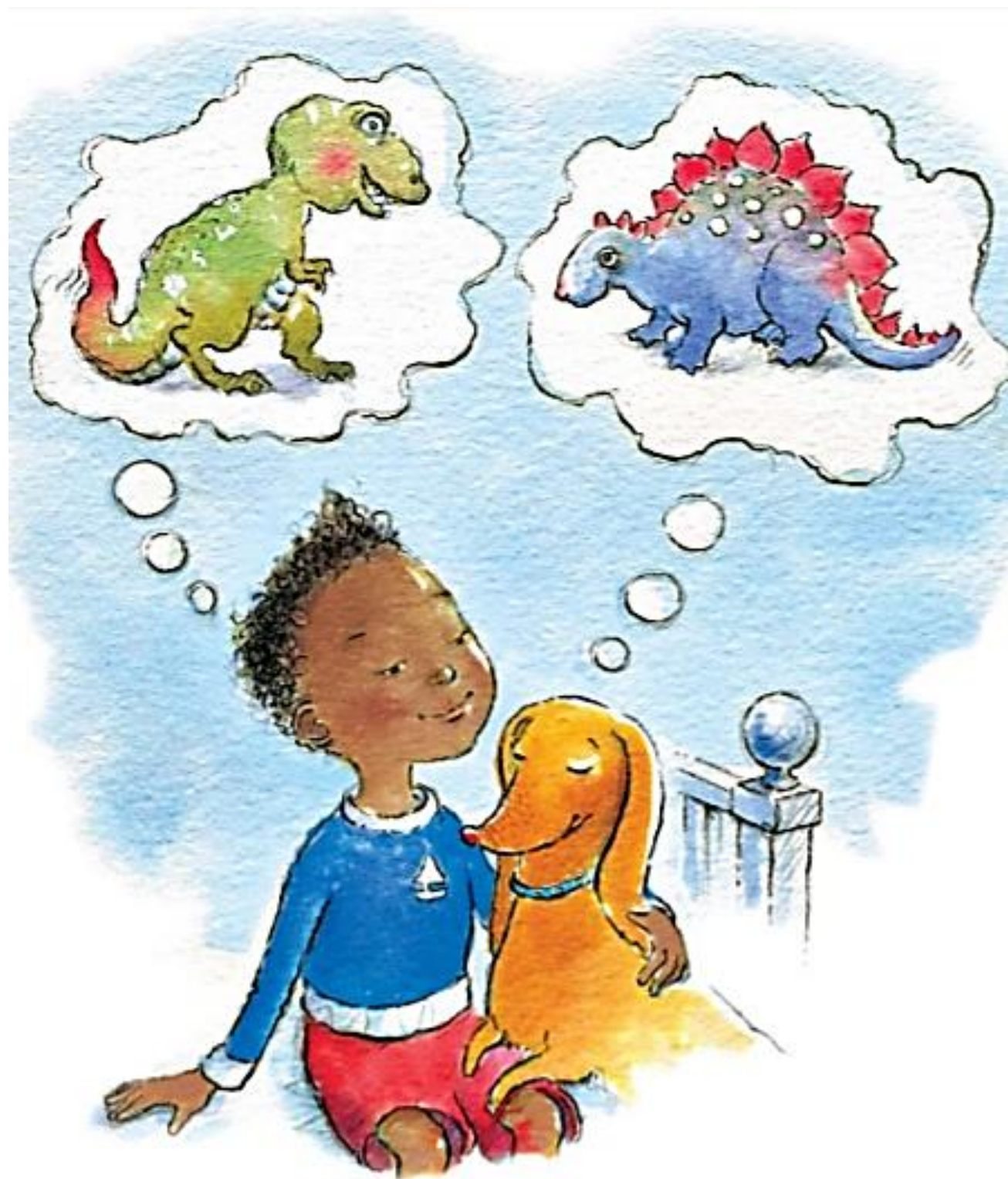
Can Jones dig it up? Can Jones carry it?
